## UPDATE

Due to impending weather the weekend of February 12 -14, the scheduled overnight closures of I-95 southbound for concrete barrier and striping installation will shift one week to start over the weekend of February 20-22 and close overnight again February 23-25.

### I-95 SB Overnight Closure for Concrete Barriers and Striping Installation

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) announces to motorists that the installation of concrete barriers and striping will require the overnight closure of I-95 Southbound in Wilmington. During the overnight closures of I-95 Southbound, motorists may take alternate routes I-495 or US 13 to their destination.

#### Times and Dates (pending weather):

**2 SB Right Lanes Closed** – 9 PM on Friday February 19 until 10 PM on Saturday February 20, 2021.

**Full SB Closure** - 10 PM on Saturday February 20 until 6:30 AM on Sunday, February 21, 2021.

**Full SB Closure** - 10 PM on Sunday, February 21 until 4 AM on Monday, February 22, 2021.

#### Location:

I-95 Southbound between Exit 6 (MLK Boulevard/ 4th Street) and I-95/I-495 Southbound Merge.

#### Detour:

Motorists will take Exit 6 (MLK Boulevard/ 4th Street) onto North Jackson Street and proceed to turn left onto Martin Luther King Boulevard, then turn right onto South Market Street/ US 13 Southbound to I-495 south exit to I-95 Southbound.



**Times and Dates (pending weather):**

**Full Closure** - 10 PM on Tuesday, February 23 until 4 AM on Wednesday, February 24, 2021.

**Full Closure** - 10 PM on Wednesday, February 24 until 4 AM on Thursday, February 25, 2021.

**Location:**

I-95 Southbound between Exit 7B (SR 52 North/Delaware Ave) and I-95 Southbound On-Ramp from 2nd Street

**Detour Route:** Motorists will exit off of Exit 7B onto North Jackson Street and continue south then turn left onto Martin Luther King Boulevard, turn left onto North Adams Street, and turn left onto 2nd Street to merge left onto the I-95 Southbound On-Ramp.



Detour signage will be posted for motorists.
